The City of Greenville **Planning Commission** will hold an in-person Public Hearing Continuance on **Monday, May 15, 2023, at 4:00 PM** at the **Prisma Health Welcome Center at Unity Park, 111 Welborn Street** for the purpose of considering the following applications. The purpose of this notice is to provide a fixed date, time, and location for a Public Hearing Continuance pursuant to Section 19-2.2.18(A)(5) of the City of Greenville Code of Ordinances as the Planning Commission did not vote on these applications at its Public Hearing on March 30, 2023 or Public Hearing Continuance on April 11, 2023. At the the Public Hearing Continuance, the chairperson will reopen the public comment portion of the meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Z-1-2023A

Application by the City of Greenville to adopt a new **City of Greenville Development Code** to replace **Chapter 19 – Land Management Ordinance**, of the current Code of Ordinances, City of Greenville, South Carolina.

B. Z-1-2023B

Application by the City of Greenville to adopt a new **Official Zoning Map** and replace the current **Official Zoning Map** for the City of Greenville.

Revised documents will be provided at least 15 days ahead of the meeting.

Comments on A and B will be received together.

Following the public hearing, the Planning Commission will act upon the applications. The Commission's actions for the following types of applications constitute a **Recommendation to the City Council**:

- Matters pertaining to the Comprehensive Plan
- Amendments to the text of the Land Management Ordinance (Zoning/Land Development Regulations) – **New Business Item(s) A**
- Amendments to the Zoning District Map (including 'Planned Developments' and 'Flexible Review Districts') – **New Business Item(s) B**
- Planning-related studies and plans

The City Council will consider these items at scheduled, public Meetings (two readings of an ordinance to either approve, or disapprove, a proposal are required). You will not receive a separate notice of those meetings, but you are invited to attend and register with the City Clerk if you wish to comment upon an Application at the Meeting(s). You may contact the City Clerk's Office at (864) 467-4441 to verify the date of the City Council Meeting or refer to the meeting schedule reflected on the City's web site (www.greenvillesc.gov).

Public Comment Instructions

The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on combined applications. Each speaker is limited to 3 minutes. Repetitive statements should be avoided; individuals sharing similar concerns are encouraged to appoint a spokesperson to represent their group. Procedure for Public Comment PRIOR TO Meeting

You may submit written comments to: Planning & Development Office, PO Box 2207, Greenville, SC 29602 or by email at planning@greenvillesc.gov. Written comments must be received by 12PM, Friday, May 12th before the hearing in order to be given adequate time for consideration by the Commission before the hearing. Comments received after 12PM Friday will be provided to the Commission at the hearing. Please reference the application number and include your name and address on all correspondence. All comments will be made part of the public record.

Procedure for Public Comment DURING Meeting

1. At the the Public Hearing Continuance, the chairperson will reopen the public comment portion of the meeting. Members of the public wishing to speak should approach the podium as directed by the chairperson.
2. Each member of the public will have 3 minutes to speak. When speaking:
 - a. Begin by clearly stating your name and address for the record. Please spell your name if it is prone to be misspelled. The 3-minute timer will start after you provide this information.
 - b. Please do not repeat information already presented by someone else and avoid off-topic statements. Those who wish to share similar concerns are encouraged to appoint a spokesperson to speak on behalf of the group.
 - c. Direct all comments and questions to the chairperson. The chairperson may respond or direct the question to the appropriate party for response.
3. Once all public comment has been provided, the public portion for that specific agenda item will be closed.
