**Motion - Executive Session**

Mayor White asked for a motion to go into Executive Session. City Attorney Leigh Paoletti recommended going into executive session under S.C. Code §30-4-70(a)(1) to discuss boards and commissions appointments and to discuss a personnel matter; (a)(2) to receive legal advice covered by the attorney-client privilege regarding two zoning litigation matters and a recently filed civil action alleging negligent construction, maintenance and repair of the roadway and sidewalks; and to discuss negotiations incidental to a contractual arrangement related to a public private partnership on Pendleton Street; and (a)(5) to discuss a matter regarding the inclusion of property in the city limits in an MCIP for the purpose of encouraging business expansion within the city.

Councilmember Gibson moved, seconded by Councilmember Brasington, to go into Executive Session. The motion carried unanimously.
